LA SELLA TENNIS AND PADEL

The club is a privately owned Padel and Tennis facility, open to the public. Nestled in the centre of the La Sella Urbanisation, the club is only 15 minutes from the beautiful coastal town of Denia, close to the Mount Montgo Natural Park.

The club currently has 5 traditional clay tennis courts, a further 2 artificial grass courts, in addition to 2 deluxe Padel courts. Changing rooms and showers are available at the club, as well as a small pro-shop. Adjacent to the club, overlooking the courts is the Bar Restaurante Giramondo, where breakfast, lunch and dinner are available, as well as coffees, snacks and drinks. A small supermarket is also open daily next to the club.

Our aim is to share with you our passion for Padel and Tennis with a desire to ensure our personal service caters to your needs so you can enjoy your holiday in this stunning place. Whether you are a beginner, a regular social or competition player, or a team, we are confident you will enjoy every moment of your trip.

DENIA

This vibrant and cosmopolitan Port City is situated at the Northern tip of Alicante Province, on the Costa Blanca and has throughout centuries been rich in both history and culture. Of the many tourist destinations on the Costa Blanca, Denia is one of the most attractive and still operates as a true Spanish working town. The resort offers 15km of blue flag sandy beaches to the North, whilst to the South, the more rugged coastline of Les Rotes with its spectacular coves and crystal waters, provide a paradise for both diving and snorkelling.



The Port of Denia, overlooked by the 753m Mount Montgo and the fabulous Castle, offers a showcase to the beauty of this historical town. Port Denia still operates a very active fishing industry as well as being the maritime link for ferries to Ibiza, Mallorca or Formentera. Denia Castle is the main tourist attraction of the town and often hosts cultural events and dramatised tours. Denia's old town and the historical centre of Denia, have a special charm, which reflect the ancient history of this lively city. Denia also hosts over 15 Fiestas each year, each offering a glimpse into Spanish culture, often with fireworks.

FOOD & ACCOMMODATION

Unesco recognised Denia as a Creative City of Gastronomy in 2015. This designation focuses on the city's traditional heritage rooted in the local fishing industry and local rice fields. Denia is known for its great rice and seafood dishes, however with over 400 bars and restaurants, from the 3 Michelin Quique Dacosta to traditional bustling tapas bars, there is something for every budget and palate.*



Els Magazinos is the new artisanal gastronomic market in Denia, in the Baix de la Mar area, with over 20 places to eat. Accommodation options can be arranged to suit all party sizes, budgets and locations. Most clients choose to stay in Denia, in order to enjoy all that city has to offer, once the Padel and Tennis is over for the day.

The Hostal Loreto, right in the heart of the historic old town, has become a favourite of many clients. Despite being 450 years old, the hotel offers everything you could need. It is just a stone's throw away from a choice of glorious beaches, the vibrant Port area, the castle and many stylish shops and boutiques. As soon as you step out onto the street you find yourself in the atmospheric gastronomic quarter, with more than 25 top quality restaurants to choose from in the old town alone. The 15 minute transfer from Denia to the courts and return, can all be arranged and included in your holiday.









TOURS & ACTIVITIES

Denia is only 1 hour from both Alicante and Valencia and consequently can be easily accessed by car for a city visit. This can be arranged for you and your party to include bike hire, tour guide information and suggested restaurant options. The lively bustling town of Benidorm is only 30 minutes down the coast and there are many traditional Spanish towns and villages both in the mountains and along the coastline to enjoy. All have their own charm and can be easily reached by car. Many local vineyards and Bodegas offer tours, including Les Freses, in Jesus Pobre, only 5 minutes drive from the courts.



In and around Denia itself, you can enjoy many other activities. Try sailing, windsurfing, jet-skiing or flyboarding. You can also head beneath the waves and discover the fascinating underwater world on a scuba or diving trip. Play a round of golf at the internationally renowned 27 hole, La Sella Golf Course, designed in 1991 by Jose Maria Olazabal. Cycling, horse riding, walking, hiking and fishing are all very popular in the area and can be arranged as part of your trip.
